Alternatively, a walk around the ancient city walls is a must, taking in views of the 15th century historic Minster as you go. Hop on a sightseeing bus to discover some of York's highlights, take a boat cruise on the beautiful river Ouse or explore its many interesting museums including the National Railway Museum, Yorkvik and the Castle Museum. There really is something for everyone in York!
